Delhi, the 19<sup>th</sup> January, 2004

No.F.13/7/94/DCP/HP-II/344:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution; read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No.F.27/59/Him(I) dated the 13<sup>th</sup> July, 1959 and F.24/78/68-DF(S) dated the 24<sup>th</sup> September, 1968, the Lt. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi, after prior consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, is pleased –

- (i) to make rules in the Schedule hereto annexed regarding the method of recruitment and qualifications necessary for appointment to various Group 'A' and 'B' posts in the Directorate of Prosecution, Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi.
- (ii) to cancel the Notification No.F.2(26)/84-S.II dated the 28<sup>th</sup> January, 1987 containing the recruitment rules for the appointment to the post of (i) Director of Prosecution, (ii) Chief Prosecutor and (iii) Senior/Additional Public Prosecutor, and to cancel Notification No.13/19/94-Home (P)/Estt./1952 dated the 14<sup>th</sup> May, 1995 and corrigendum No.13/19/94-Home(P)/Estt./389 dated the 21<sup>st</sup> January, 1998 containing the recruitment rules for the appointment to the post of Assistant Public Prosecutor, Directorate of Prosecution, Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi.

### RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF DIRECTOR(PROSECUTION) IN THE DIRECTORATE OF PROSECUTION, GOVERNMENT OF NCT OF DELHI ORGANISATION NAME : HOME (POLICE-II) DEPARTMENT

4. Scale of pay (Rs.) : Rs. 12000-375-16500
5. Whether selection or non-selection post : Selection
6. Age limit for direct recruitment : N.A.
7. Whether benefit of added years of service admissible. : N.A.
8. Educational and other qualification required for direct recruitment : N.A.
9. Whether age and education qualification prescribed for direct recruitment rules will apply in the case of promotees : N.A.

1. Name of Post : Additional Public Prosecutor
2. No. of Post : 79\*\*(2003) Subject to variation dependent on workload.
3. Classification : GCS Group 'A' Gazetted Non-Ministerial

4. Scale of pay (Rs.) : Rs. 8000-275-13500
5. Whether selection or non-selection post : Selection
6. Age limit for direct recruitment : N.A.
7. Whether benefit of added years of service admissible. : N.A.
8. Educational and other qualification required for direct recruitment : N.A.
9. Whether age and education qualification prescribed for direct recruitment rules will apply in the case of promotees : N.A.

The suitability of the regular holder of the post of Additional Public Prosecutor in the scale of Rs.2375-3500 (pre-revised) will be initially assessed by the Commission for appointment to the upgraded post in the scale of Rs.8000-13500(Revised Scale). If assessed suitable, he/she shall be deemed to have been appointed to the post at the initial constitution. If assessed 'not suitable' for appointment to the upgraded post, he/she shall continue to be in the revised scale of Rs.7450-11500 and their case would be reviewed every years.
12. In case of recruitment by promotion/ deputation/absorption Grades from which promotion/deputation/absorption to be made : **Promotion** : Assistant Public Prosecutor in the scale of Rs.6500-10500 with seven years regular service in the Grade.

**Note:** Where juniors who have completed their qualifying/eligibility are being considered for promotion, their seniors would so be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying/eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying/eligibility service.
